Malawi's HIV prevalence is one of the highest in the world, with 9.2% of the adult population (aged 15-49) living with HIV.¹ An estimated one million Malawians were living with HIV in 2016 and 24,000 Malawians died from AIDS-related illnesses in the same year.² The Malawian HIV epidemic plays a critical role in the country's low life expectancy of just 57 years for men and 60 for women.³
