History Founding myth. In the founding myth, even the town's name is linked to the goddess, as the eponymous Paphos was the son (or, in Ovid, daughter) of Pygmalion whose ivory cult image of Aphrodite was brought to life by the goddess as "milk-white" Galatea.. The author of Bibliothekē, the Hellenistic encyclopedia of myth long attributed to Apollodorus, gives the genealogy.
