Brass players vibrate their lips into a mouthpiece attached to the instrument. The smallest in size and the highest pitched of the brass family is the trumpet, with its cylindrical bore and valves.

In place of a bell, the haotong had a long, broad cylinder made of wood, iron or brass, into which the rest of the instrument could be telescoped when not in use; the haotong was played with the bell end resting on the ground. The ordinary Chinese trumpet was the laba (rappa in Japanese).
