In a random sample of 1,000 publications reporting the effects of point polluters on terrestrial biota (a history of creation of the collection of primary studies was briefly described by Kozlov & Zvereva 2003; Zvereva et al. 2), only 9% of publications reported the effects of two or more polluters; even among these studies, only rarely was the question asked whether some effects were shared among the studied impact zones.
