SOIL MANAGEMENT Mechanical, physical and cultural crop protection methods prevent or minimize pests as well as reduce their build-up and carryover from one crop to another. For example, traditional ploughing (â€œtillageâ€•) turns the soil and buries crop residue and weeds before the seed bed is prepared for the next crop.
