The skin is composed of three layers, the epidermis (50–100 μ m), dermis (1–2 mm) and hypodermis (1–2 mm) (Figure 1.6.1). The barrier to percutaneous absorption lies within the stratum corneum, the most superficial layer of the epidermis.
