Management of Change, or MOC, is a best practice used to ensure that safety, health and environmental risks are controlled when a company makes changes in their facilities, documentation, personnel, or operations.

Change request is documented and approved by the Departmental Team and Departmental Team Leader. Change request is forwarded to appropriate Manager(s). Manager(s) log change request and verify change completeness/accuracy. Manager(s) review the overall impact of the change request (time/resources etc).
