Paracrine Interactions of Thyroid Hormones and Thyroid

The prevalence of thyroid autoimmunity and subclinical hypothyroidism is significant among women of reproductive age. It is estimated that the incidence of autoimmune thyroid disease is 8-14 percent and is the most common cause of hypothyroidism among young women.

Autoimmune and Subclinical Hypothyroidism in Reproductive

The thyroid hormones triiodothyronine (T 3) and thyroxine (T 4) are produced and secreted by the thyroid gland in response to thyroid-stimulating hormone (TSH) from the anterior pituitary. Synthesis of the amino acid-derived T 3 and T 4 hormones requires iodine.
